Starting Wednesday, September 8 and on each subsequent Thursday in September, the Human Rights Office will host a screening of a documentary that focuses on issues relevant to Catholics today. Please join us for any or all of these powerful films!

All films begin at 7 PM.

September 8 – *War Child* at Screenland Armour (408 Armour Rd., Kansas City, MO 64116). A film that centers on issues of war and peace in Sudan, *War Child* tells the story of Sudanese child soldier Emmanuel Jal, who is now a rapper and peace activist.

September 16 – *No Tomorrow* at Tivoli Theatre (4050 Pennsylvania Ave., Kansas City, MO 64111). When a young woman featured in a recent documentary is brutally murdered, the film itself becomes central to whether the killer lives or dies. This story offers a unique window into the controversies surrounding the death penalty.

September 23 – *La Americana* at Avila University (11901 Wornall Rd., Kansas City, MO 64145). *La Americana* is the touching, politically relevant story of a young mother who emigrates from South America to the United States in order to pay her daughter's medical bills.

September 30 – *Sin by Silence* at Rockhurst University (1100 Rockhurst Rd., Kansas City, MO 64110). *Sin by Silence* tells the stories of several women imprisoned for murdering their abusive spouses and educates the viewer on the various forms and signs of domestic abuse.
