

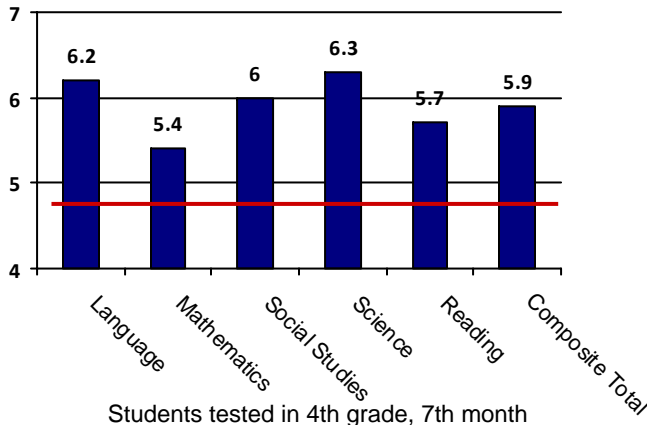

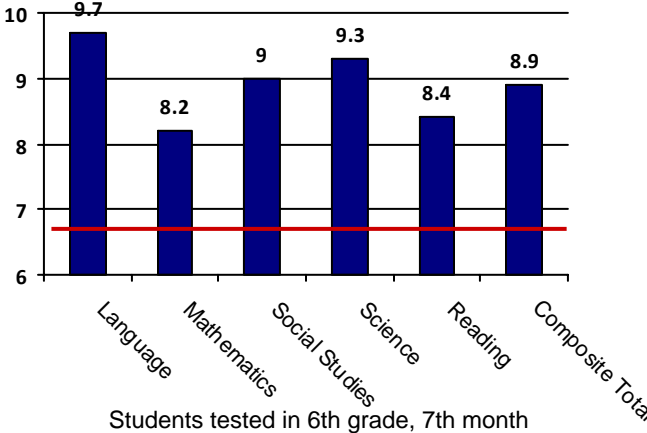
Iowa Tests of Basic Skills

The Iowa Tests of Basic Skills (ITBS) are national standardized tests administered annually in the Diocese. The tests offer one measurement of progress.

March 2011 ~ Grade Level Equivalency

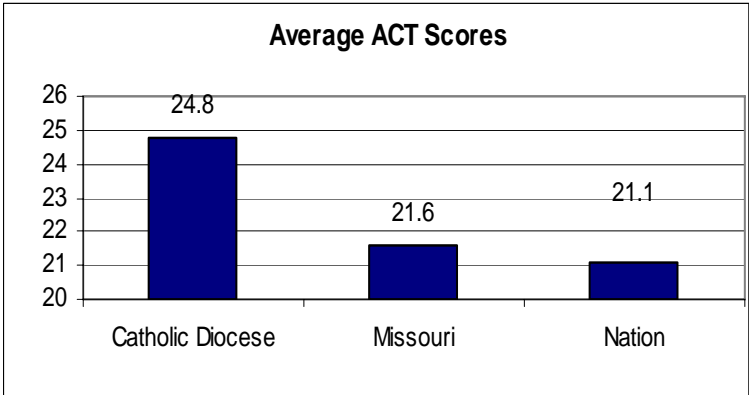


6th Grade ITBS

The ACT Assessment measures the general educational development of high school students. Testing outcomes are one predictor of the potential to complete college-level work.





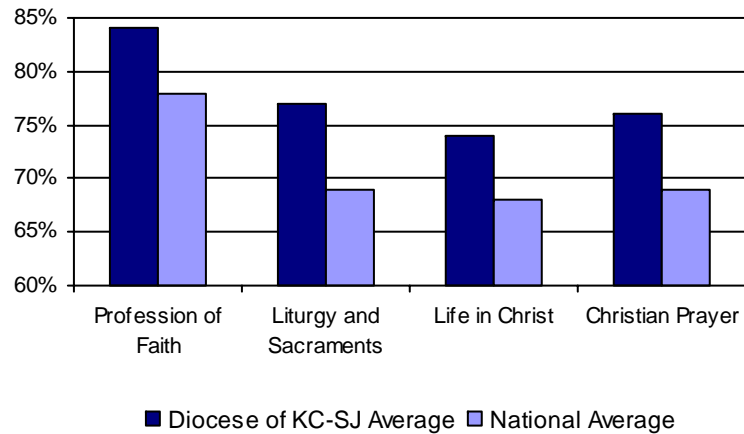
HOW WE MEASURE UP ~ National Assessments

Knowledge of the Faith

The Assessment of Catholic Religious Education (ACRE) test measures knowledge of the faith as well as beliefs, behaviors, attitudes and practices of the faith. ACRE carries the endorsement of the NCEA and is based upon the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*.
